## **Preface**

The women's college of education was established in June, 1990 by well known reputed Tapi Valley Education Society, Faizpur.(TVES formed in 1960) The college is located in TVE Society's campus namely Nehru Vidyanagar, Faizpur (approximately 32 acres) situated between the two talukas namely Yawal and Raver of Jalgaon District. The TVE Society is running five educational institutions.

In the Nehru Vidyanagar the First Session of the Indian National Congress (1936) ever to be held in a rural area under the president ship of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru. The heroes of our National Freedom Movement, Mahatma Gandhi, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, Sardar Vallabhabhai Patel, Sane Guruji and many others presents the session. Local great freedom fighter Late Dhanaji Nana Chaudhari was the main host of this session. The TVE Society's former President late Balasaheb Madhukarrao Dhanaji Chaudhari (Ex-speaker Maharashtra State Legislative Assembly) was the son of this personality. Now the son of late Madhukarrao Chaudhari Hon'ble Shirishdada Chaudhari (Member of Legislative Assembly Maharashtra State) is the secretary of TVE Society.

The institution is recognized by National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) in the western region vide letter No. WRC/5-6/20/2000/7463 dtd. Oct. 5, 2000.

The institution affiliated to North Maharashtra University.

The institution is running under graduate course in education with intake capacity 80 students per year on non- grant basis. From this year the institution started the new course of YCMOU Nashik i.e. M.A./M.Com/ M.Sc. (Subject – communication).

In the institution one faculty having Doctoral degree ,three faculty having Master of Philosophy degree in Education and one faculty passed M.Phil but the degree is not awarded yet.

We have prepared the Annual Quality Assurance Report exactly on the basis of the guidelines formulated by NAAC. With great pride and pleasure, we state that we have gone through a process of honest introspection of each and every aspect while preparing this Annual Report.
